Constructed in goncalo alves, having block end bases on winged feet with castors, the angles having cotton reel turnings, the columns turned, tapered and carved with stiff leaf adornments, with a tapered and ring turned stretcher, the top having radiused corners, with two mahogany lined drawers with quadrant moulding in the frieze, and a conforming 'cotton reel' edging. England, Circa 1825.
