A Good Wine Cooler Of the Regency Period

Constructed in a finely patinated <u>San Domingo mahogany</u>; rising from oblate bun feet, of waisted sarcophagus form, dressed with ribbands in the Roman manner; the canted top having a tablet finial, hinged, and revealing a lead lined interior. Circa 1825
