Constructed in Carrara marble and gilt bronze; the square stepped bases having incurved angles, and supporting bronze socles dressed with pendant bellflowers, holding baluster form urns decorated with loop handles, issuing triple foliate form arms, with cannellure cast bobèches, and conforming drip pans.
