Constructed using a fine Honduras mahogany with gilt highlights, Bleu Tarquin marble and richly dressed with [fire gilt ormolu mounts](#) of the highest quality. The table of lyre end support design, rising from ormolu claw feet, conjoined with a rectangular shaped platform stretcher; three lockable mahogany lined drawers are fitted in the apron; the dished rectangular marble platform having an ormolu trimmed octagonal adjustable swing mirror, supported by shaped columns, rising from triangulated bases, each column dressed with double candleholders.
