AN IMPORTANT PAIR OF TORCHÈRES IN THE LOUIS XV MANNER

Constructed in patinated and silvered bronze, and rouge brecciated marble; rising from serpentine marble bases, trimmed with silvered bronze tied canelures, the tripartite scrolled legs issue columns incorporating adorsed syrinxes, holding reeded Pan pipes, supporting the coronas, having six candle branches, fitted with bulb holders. Bearing serial numbers to the backs, 3059 & 29126.
