A GILTWOOD MIRROR IN THE GEORGE III STYLE

The elliptical mirror plate enclosed by gesso and gilt wood frames, exuberantly carved with scrolling acanthi, foliates and scrollwork in the Rococo manner, the surmounts having cabochons issuing acanthus spray crests.
