A MID-NINETEENTH CENTURY OCTAGONAL LIBRARY TABLE

Constructed in mahogany, and having a revolving octagonal top; the base of tripartite incurved form, richly adorned with carved anthemions, lotus flowers, volutes and spandrels, and set on castors; the tapering and incurved truncated pyramidal base conformingly carved; four faux, and four true drawers in the frieze, bearing patent locks from Mordan of Castle Street London, and the platform having an inset tooled Morocco leather, with a running gadroon edge.
