The single armchair constructed from mahogany, the tablet top rail with central cast brass mount of two opposed swans holding a banner, the back, arms and seat covered in red neoclassical fabric, down scrolled arms with anthemion carved motifs, on stiff leaf carved scrolled sabre legs.

The chair and its upholstery are directly inspired by the bergère made by François-Honoré-Georges Jacob-Desmlater for Queen Hortense when she ruled over Holland alongside her husband Louis
