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The white glazed ceramic bust representing Diana, goddess of the hunt and the moon, wearing the attribute of the crescent moon as a diadem, a toga draped over her shoulder as she glances sideways. On a velvet covered socle. Signed 'A. Louis. Carrier-Belleuse.' French, circa 1895

Son of the famous sculptor Albert-Ernest Carrier-Belleuse, Louis-Robert became director of the Choisy-le-roi faience factory in 1889, which produced this bust after his design.
