A Superb Looking Glass In the manner of Thomas Chippendale

The oval mercury glass plate housed within an ornate <u>rococo</u> carved and pierced <u>giltwood</u> frame, composed of 'C' scrolls, flowering branchwork, and stylised acanthus leaves.
