A Magnificent Pair of Console Tables in the Manner of [William Kent](#)

Of arc-en-arpalette form, constructed in [giltwood](#), with marble platforms. The swept and channelled legs rest on oblate bun feet, the toes and shoulders being adorned with oak leaves and a comprehensive imbricated pattern, terminating in eagle's heads. The birds' beaks hold a running garland of fruit and flowers, issuing from centred scallop shells, the allegorical representations of regeneration, and the divine feminine principle of creation. The friezes are adorned with addorsed Vitruvian scrolls; over, ovolo mouldings frame and support the platforms of shaped Rouge Royale marble.
