A particularly refined and accomplished example of late nineteenth century Italian sculpture, carved from white [statuary marble](#), an Italian shepherd boy poised confidently in contrapposto, dressed in traditional farmer's clothes including the ciocie sandals and a calabash at his waist as he balances a walking stick across his shoulders and casts an affectionate glance to his left.

The base inscribed with the Italian title "Quanto Ti Vo Bene", and signed 'C. Lapini / Firenze 1890.' Italian, dated 1890
