A Pair of Mahogany Chippendale Style Armchairs

Based on [Thomas Chippendale's](#) original design from 1753 for 'French Chairs,' the armchairs on cabriole carved legs terminating in ball and claw feet, with rectangular stuffed seats, the backrests of serpentine outline, carved with [rococo](#) ornament, C-scrolled acanthus designs and a central cartouche at the apex, each chair having outswept padded armrests with scrolled and acanthus clasped supports.
