The [gilt](#) chairs of typical carved beech and construction 'à chassis' allowing the backrest and seat to be removed from the frame, the chairs designed along symmetrical Rococo principles, with cabriole legs, 'whiplash' carved armrests and scrolling acanthus leaves applied to the surface, the seat rail & top rail crest with carved floral bouquets. The back supports incised with trellis decoration and a seashell motif at the apex.
