Carved from Lindenwood, a large bear standing on a naturalistic base fitted with drip tray, having a carved ring to holds sticks and umbrellas and grasping a tree branch designed to hold hats and coats, fitted with a bevelled glass mirror and having a small bear perched above.

Brienz, in the Bernese Oberland, Switzerland was remarked upon in Baedeker's Travel Guide, as having a population of 2400, of whom 600 persons were employed as woodcarvers, to supply the tourist trade to Switzerland with mementos of the tour.
